Only one single family with necessary building and not exceeding two stories in height may be erected or maintained on said lots. No fence, wall, hedge or other planting shall be maintained on the lot between the street and a line to be within 10 feet from the line of a street line with the edge of a driveway, pavement, or alley line. No tree shall be permitted to remain within such distance of such intersection unless the foliage line is maintained at sufficient height to prevent the tree from shading the street.
3. No tree shall be permitted on any lot in this addition having a ground floor area of less than 900 square feet and no one and one-half story house having a ground floor area of less than 600 square feet shall be erected or maintained on any lot in this addition.
