C. E. King's Southeastern Ave. Addition

An Addition to the City of Indianapolis and a Subdivision of part of the east half of the North east quarter of Section Seven (7) Township Eighteen (18) North Range Four (4) East in Madison County, State of Indiana, described as follows;

Beginning on the north line of English Avenue at a point two hundred fifteen and eight hundredths (215 8/100) feet west of the east line and thirty (30) feet north of the south line of said quarter section and running west with the north line of English Avenue one hundred forty (40) feet. Thence north parallel to the east line of said quarter six hundred fifteen (15) feet to the south line of Southeastern Avenue. Thence with the south line of said quarter westerly one hundred forty eight and four tenths (148 4/10) feet. Thence with the east line of said quarter westerly one hundred (100) feet, to the beginning containing one and ninety hundredths (1 90/100) acres. This subdivision consists of 51 lots, with street and alleys with size and numbers of lots, and width of street and alleys marked on this plat. Distances given in feet and decimals.

* The half street and alleys on hereby dedicated to public use.

U. 20 (215 8/100) feet west of east line and (30) feet north of south line of said quarter section. U. 21-23 parallel to the east line of said quarter section. A. 23-25 is the north line of English Ave. and (30) feet north of the south line of quarter section.*
