


PLAT OF ROBINSON'S SUBDIVISION OF LOTS,
 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 52 and 53, IN
 JOHN HERRIOT'S NORTH ADDITION,
 TO THE CITY OF FRANKLIN.



Franklin, Dec 6 1903

To the Honorable Mayor and common council of the City of Franklin, Burlington,
 The undersigned petitioners Respectfully Represent to your honorable body that they are owners of all the
 land adjacent to the alley herein after named and all that will in any way be affected by the changes
 hereinafter asked for; they also show that certain lots and alleys are so located in John Kenneth's North
 Addition to the City of Franklin that if buildings are placed on said lots the outbuilding and rear
 of the houses will necessarily be placed next to the Coleridge Railroad line and said petitioners hereby
 show to said council that they desire to so change the location of certain alleys in said addition
 that certain lots lying adjacent to said Coleridge line may be thrown together and divided
 in the other direction and thus make it possible to build houses on said lots fronting on
 said electric line and said petitioners herewith present a plot of said lots and alleys
 showing them as they are now located and as they would appear after said change wherefore
 under the provision of Section 3653 the Revised Statutes of 1901 the said petitioners hereby petition
 your honorable board to make the following change to wit 50 feet to the alley running north
 and south between lots 31 and 32 in said addition; also between lots 33 and 30, ^{one} said and
 34 and 29 on the other side; also between lots 15 and 16; and in place thereof to locate one
 continuous alley commencing on the south side of "G" Street in said addition 140 feet east of
 of the North west corner of lot 31; thence southeasterly parallel with the line of said electric
 Rail Road to a point on the north side of the alley between lots 17 and 18 in said addition
 140 feet east of the South west corner of lot 15; thence east 12 feet; thence North westerly parallel
 with the first line and with the said Coleridge line to the South side of said "G" Street; thence
 west 12 feet to the place of beginning.


