In the event storm water drainage from any one lot flows across another lot, provisions shall be made to prevent such drainage to continue, without restriction or reduction, across the down-slope lot and into the natural drainage channel or carrier, even though no specific drainage arrangement for such flow or water is provided on said site.

No animals, investors, or members of any organization shall be raised, kept, or bred on any lot, property, town, village, or other household here on, to be kept, restricted that they are not kept, bred or maintained for purposes of sale.

No, it will not be well used or maintained as a damping ground for vehicles, trailers, etc., for other uses, and it shall not be used, except in specially circumstances. Trash may be burned only in suitable incinerators.

The undersigned do hereby agree, that the right to enjoin the enforcement of these provisions by injunction, together with the right to sue for specific performance of any or any other covenants or restrictions contained in this instrument, or to recover damages for any violation thereof, shall be retained by the several numbers of the original heirs in their respective shares in this instrument, and by their heirs and executors.
